

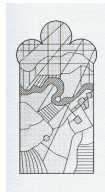
General Information

St John the Evangelist Toft is a rural Anglican parish church enjoying an evangelical tradition centred upon Biblical teaching and exposition.

10.15am Morning Worship is the principal church family meeting. The church family comprises people from all kinds of backgrounds, cultures and ages. Meeting together is an important expression of the family.
