NEW ELECTORAL ROLLS

By law Anglican churches have to create a new electoral roll every 6 years. This means that everyone has to fill in a new form in order to be included. Forms are being sent out to everyone currently on either church roll. Where possible this will be done via email, with paper copies to those who don't have an email address. The forms can be printed out and returned by hand, or scanned and returned electronically, but they must be returned to the church office by 17th March in order to be added to the new roll. Being on the electoral roll means that you can vote at the Annual Meeting, and you can receive up to date information about church matters on a regular basis. Forms are available at the back of church if you need one.

GIFT DAY

Remember that next Sunday, 3rd March, is our Gift Day. It's an opportunity to make a one-off gift and it would be great to make up last year's £21,000 shortfall in our normal income (£255,000). However, a church ideally needs a strong financial base without relying on one-off gestures. Solid, sustainable Christian work is built on regular, committed and sacrificial giving. The Gift Day is also an opportunity to review our regular giving in the light of the Bible's teaching on money that we heard in January's mini sermon series. It's early days in 2019, but unless we also increase our regular giving by this amount we'll face a similar deficit this year. Thank you for helping to support God's work here at St John's. An update on the Gift Day and the first quarter of this year will be given at the APCM on 14th April when we'll have a better picture of how 2019 is looking.
