SOME BELL RINGING NEWS

On Sunday August 5th, a team of bell ringers from around the Chester diocese met at Knutsford to ring a quarter peal of "Grandsire Triples", consisting of 1260 changes. ("Grandsire" is ancient composition dating back to 1650). The ringing, conducted by George T. Basford a young ringer from Nantwich, reached a consistently high standard throughout, in spite of some movement in the bell frame which renders the bells a little difficult to handle. It was the consensus of the team to ring the quarter to mark the ordination of Ian Chidlow of Knutsford, to be curate at St. Mary's Cheadle, this was appropriate as the ringing master from Cheadle was part of the team.
