## **CHRISTIANS AGAINST POVERTY BEFRIENDER**

A befriender is someone who has a heart for people and lives out what it means to build community. Befrienders work closely with Barney, the Hope Central Debt Coach, accompanying him on visits and focusing on non-debt related needs of the client e.g. facilitating bringing the client into the community, identifying hobbies and other points of social connection, providing assistance with practical tasks, sharing the Gospel.

This role is client facing, and would suit someone with good relationship-building skills, an open and non-judgemental nature together with a heart and resilience to serve.

The role is flexible with regard to what elements you undertake and how much time you are able to give. CAP will provide training to equip you in the way that fits best with you and your community.

## **HOPE CENTRAL**

At the moment, Hope Central has lower stocks of UHT semi-skimmed milk, tinned potatoes and tomatoes, cereals, tinned fruit, toilet rolls, tinned pasta and shampoo. All financial contributions are gratefully received as well, to enable the development of other support services planned for the near future, including the debt support we heard about recently.

## **DAILY HOPE PHONE LINE**

DailyHope, a free national telephone line, offers music, prayers and reflections as well as full worship services from the Church of England at the end of the phone. The line – which is available 24 hours a day on 0800 804 8044 – has been set up particularly with those unable to join online church services during the period of restrictions in mind; to provide comfort and spiritual nourishment to the most isolated in our society. It is free.

## **OASIS**

Oasis has been run for many years as a popular group for Mums and carers with pre-school children in the Church Centre by volunteers from within our Church family.

Prior to the pandemic, Oasis was held on 3 mornings a week during term time providing a link between St John's Church and approximately 70 families in the community. The children were introduced to the teaching of the Bible through short bible stories, backed up by simple crafts and songs.

After a prolonged break it is planned to restart Oasis in a pared down format in September. Initially Oasis will be held on one morning a week, for a maximum of 20 families. It is therefore hoped to run the group with a rota of helpers in the room with the children and others in the kitchen serving refreshments.

Since we last met circumstances have changed for many of our former helpers, so we are asking for volunteers to help with the proposed restart of Oasis.

Would you be able to spare one or two mornings a month to help with this important work in our Church? Please talk to one of us via the Church office if you would like to find out more about what we do at Oasis or let us know if you have any suggestions about the restart.

It would mean a lot to many Mums and carers to be able to come back to our Church Centre again!
