HOPE CENTRAL

The need for food parcels has declined significantly since this time last year, although at a higher level than pre-Covid. We are seeing a significant decline in food and financial giving as well. The pandemic is not over, and with your help, we are working hard to ensure that there is always enough food available to support those who need it.

Our CAP Debt Centre Manager has started work and we are already seeing referrals from Knutsford, We need volunteer befrienders to work alongside him. This is very rewarding work and the volunteer is completely in control of the time that they commit. Alongside this, we have run our first Money Management course to help people gain control of their finances and live within their means. Our plan is to try and take this activity out into schools to support young people starting off in life.

In the coming months furlough will end, the Universal Credit top-up stops and there will be a large increase in domestic fuel prices. The spectre of redundancies is raising its head as well.

We want to be there, alongside the Welcome, to be certain that nobody goes hungry and to provide people with the tools that they need to manage their finances well. We need your prayers, we need volunteers and we need money and food. The support of the Knutsford communities has been amazing so far. We pray that you continue to support us in this wonderful opportunity to demonstrate what Christians can do, and to bring God's word to everyone that we meet. Thank you. Ian R
